Annual General Meeting 19th January 2025

The Friends of Commsave Credit Union Lottery was formed with the aim of furthering the **development** of Commsave through **education**, **training** and **promoting awareness**, as well as supporting the Community Fund.

How does it work?

- The lottery is only open to members of Friends of Commsave Credit Union.
- The tickets cost just £1 per draw, and are limited to two per member per month.
- The lottery entry is deducted from savings held with Commsave Credit Union at the end of the month. However, it will not be deducted if there are insufficient funds in the account.
- The winning lottery numbers are randomly generated electronically on the last day of the month.
- The winners are notified in writing, and the money is placed into the Regular Savings account to withdraw if requested.
- A list of winning members is publicised in workplaces, on our website, and our social media pages.
- The total annual prizes are at least 50% of the total annual revenue.

Current Prize Structure

Regular monthly draw – Top prize of £500, with 29 runners-up prizes of £75.

Christmas and summer 'megadraw' – Top prize of £5,000, with 49 runners-up prizes of at least £150.
